**Course ID:** 302421                    **Description:** Foundations of Education

**Full Course Description:** This course deals with the theoretical bases on which sound educational practices are built. Students will be familiarized with the philosophical, social, political, economic and historical foundations of education, the influence of scientific disciplines on the educational phenomenon and the problems it causes.

**Course ID:** 302511                    **Description:** School Management
