Couse ID: 302421	Description: Foundations of Education
	This course deals with the theoretical bases on which sound educational practices are built. Students will be familiarized with the philosophical, social, political, economic and historical foundations of education, the influence of scientific disciplines on the educational phenomenon and the problems it causes.
Couse ID: 302511	Description: School Management

	This course addresses the concept and principles of school management, theories and practices of administration and leadership. Also, this course stresses the educational supervision, its nature, types, fields, and problems, followed by present and future states of education supervision in Jordan.
Couse ID: 302520	Description: Educational System in Jordan
Full Course Description:	This course tackles the concepts of the educational system, the forces and variables affecting this system in the world in general and in Jordan in particular, the philosophy, aims and structure of the Jordanian Educational System. Couse ID: 302522	Description: Sociology of Education
