Course ID: 204121 **Description:** Principles Of Insurance

Full Course Description: Deals with the essential concepts and principles of insurance, the legal and contractual provisions that should be existed in an insurance contract. Also the course discusses the traditional and improved types of insurance and premium paying mechanisms and the types of polices.

Course ID: 204201 **Description:** Financial Management(1)

Full Course Description: This course aims to provide the capacity to understand the theory and apply, in real world situations, the techniques that have been developed in corporate finance. Full Course Description: This course discusses the basics and concepts of specialized financial institutions , which including the commercial banks , investment banking services , brokerage services , mutual funds , insurance companies , pension funds and credit unions .To understand the process of specialized financial institutions, it is required acknowledge the role of financial markets and institutions , their sources and uses and their financial statement analyses.

Full Course Description: The law and regulations related to financial institutions such as commercial banks, central banks, pension funds, insurance companies, stock exchange, trading rules, trading regimes, exchange commissions and its regulations. The importance of these regulations in providing transparency, liquidity and efficiency.

Full Course Description: This course focuses on the short-term financing decisions or the working capital management. Areas to be covered in this course includes: introduction to the working capital management, the operating cycle, cash conversion cycle, net trade cycle, and weighted cash conversion cycle and their applications. the course also covers the cash budget, working capital policies, short-term borrowing, cash management, optimal cash level, inventory management, optimal inventory level, and receivable management.

Full Course Description: This course introduces students to the mechanics of financial markets. The emphasis is on how markets work, how instruments are priced and how they are traded. Also, this course discusses the types of financial markets and international financial crises and recent international developments.

Course ID: 204321 **Description:** Credit Management

Full Course Description: This module provides students with theoretical knowledge and understanding of key selected topics in credit management within the banking systems. In addition, it familiarizes students with selected empirical issues and methods of analysis used in the banks' credit departments and introduce the key principles of credit management and their importance to banks. It also provide students with a solid grounding in issues of credit such as the types of credit facilities/credit line/credit packages and a description of the credit officer main functions and the way they operate in banks.

Course ID: 204322 **Description:** Realestate Financing

Full Course Description: Deals with the concepts of real estate investment, valuation and financing. Outlines the responsibilities of both the credit department and officer. and focuses on real estate loans estimation, interest rate and fees analysis, as well as payments patterns and calculation.

Course ID: 204420 **Description:** Treasury Management

Full Course Description: Deals with decisions made by the treasury managers particularly those concerned with controlling the firms' provision and uses of financial resources in order to meet the firms' interests it focuses to ward the recent developments in the finance function, and a clear appreciation of the methods that led to reasonable investment decision, in addition to the financing and dividend decision. This course will provide focus on the treasury management tools available. Course ID: 204421 **Description:** Islamic Financing

Full Course Description: Deals with the types of Islamic financial institutions and the tools for providing funds. It also explains 'Al Sharia' a 'principles like; profit and loss sharing principle, Mosharakah, Tawreeq, and Modarabah. Also, a complete comparison between Islamic banks financial statements (FIs) and commercial banks FIs will be provided.

Full Course Description: Topics covered in this course include Asset -Liability Management Techniques and Hedging Against interest rate and credit risks, determining and measuring interest rates and controlling bank's interest sensitive gap, the concept of duration and managing banks duration gap, using financial and options in a bank asset-liability management.

Full Course Description: This course covers the hot issues in multinational finance like the cointegration of financial markets Topics include international risk , foreign diversification ,foreign investment .foreign exchange determination and international working capital management issues .Derivatives are explored as instruments to hedge foreign exchange risk exposure , and special markets are evaluated in the international corporate /investment setting .
